Meet the woman who sponsored two anti-abortion bills and saw them passed by the North Dakota State legislature. In March this year, the North Dakota government introduced two bills — one banning abortion after six weeks of pregnancy, the earliest that the unborn child's heartbeat can be detected, and the other prohibiting abortion because an unborn child has a genetic defect, such as Down syndrome. Doctors performing abortion under these circumstances face up to five years in prison and a \$5000 fine.

"It's a good day for babies," said, Bette Grande, a Republican from Fargo who introduced both bills.

In 2011, 92 bills against abortion made law in 24 States in the U.S., shattering the previous record of 24 in 2005. Since then a wave of restrictive laws has seen abortion effectively banned in 15 states. The latest bill passed by the U.S. House of Representatives, on Wednesday 19th June 2013, bans abortion after twenty weeks

of pregnancy, which is the time when science has demonstrated that unborn children feel pain.
